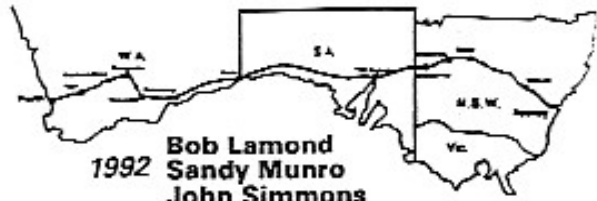


Across Australia by Motor Car

1912 First west to east crossing of Australia by an automobile – a 1910 BRUSH – Indian Ocean to the Pacific Ocean – 2,600 miles in 28 days – mainly on desert tracks and dirt roads.



In 1992 Bob, John & Sandy drove Bob's 1910 Brush from the Indian to the Pacific, commemorating the historic 1912 Expedition, in 18 days, 4132 km averaging 38.3 KPH – Bob's favourite quote to the Media was:

"The roads were 80 times better – but – the BRUSH was 80 years older"

Start with your wheels in the Indian Ocean at Fremantle then on to Perth, York Museum following the John Eyre Highway to Kalgoorlie, Eucla, across the Nullarbor Plain, Ceduna, Port Augusta, cross the Flinders Ranges onto the Barrier Highway to Broken Hill, Wilcannia, Cobar, Dubbo, Bathurst, cross the Blue Mountain Ranges and wash your wheels in the Pacific at Sydney Harbour.
